Ezra & Nehemiah Lesson #9 Nehemiah Completes the Wall

- When Sanballat, Tobiah and Gesham the Arab learned that Nehemiah was rebuilding the wall they began to <u>ridicule</u> them in order to <u>stop</u> the work.
- Satan tries to make you think what you are doing for God is <u>insignificant</u> so you will become <u>duscouraged</u> and <u>guit</u>.
- 3. Nehemiah and the men and women of Judah kept building until the wall reached half its height.
- 4. Nehemiah's enemies *plotted* to *attack* them.
- 5. Jews from other areas in Israel came to them and warned them of the plot.
- 6. Nehemiah stationed *guards* along with every *worker*.
- 7. Nehemiah had a man with him at all times who had a **shofar**. If the people heard the sound of the **shofar** they were to come to that area of the wall to help **fight**.
- 8. The people worked from <u>sun-up</u> to <u>sun-down</u>.
- 9. The leaders of the land were exacting heavy *taxes* on the poor.
- 10. The people had to sell their **sons** and **daughters** in order to buy **food**.
- 11. Nehemiah told the leaders to give back their <u>land</u> and <u>forgive</u> their <u>debts</u>.
- 12. Nehemiah was in Judah as its governor for 12 years.
- 13. Sanballat, Tobiah and the other enemies of Nehemiah invited him to meet with them in order to <u>kill</u> him but he refused to come and continued to <u>work</u> the wall.
- 14. The prophets <u>Shemaiah</u> and <u>Noahiah</u> tried to intimidate Nehemiah but they had been hired by <u>Sanballat</u>.
- 15. It took the people <u>52</u> days to complete the wall.
